Cytunwyd na ddylid disgwyl i unigolion wneud hyn ac y dylai'r cyfryngau cymdeithasol personol ac RTC/TOC fod ar wahân yn glir.

Gwirfoddolwyr – Mae 11 o wirfoddolwyr gweithgar a chytunwyd bod angen mwy i sicrhau bod Yr Hen Lys yn agor yn rheolaidd. Diolchwyd i Peter Daniels am ysgrifennu

darn ar gyfer Town & Around o safbwynt gwirfoddolwr ac mae wedi cytuno'n garedig i ailgyhoeddi'r erthygl hon. Awgrymwyd cysylltu ag Ysgol Brynhyfryd i gynnig cyfleoedd gwirfoddoli i fyfyrwyr Bagloriaeth Cymru ac i gysylltu â Chymdeithas Hanes Lleol Rhuthun, U3A a Chymdeithas Ddinesig Rhuthun a'r Cylch i holi a hoffai eu haelodau gefnogi yr Hen Lys.

4. Outstanding Actions

Interpretation – the historical display design is evolving. There has been some in place for a few weeks, and it has been observed that the flow of the information does not work as well as it could. Cllr Harris has designed a template that will add context and interest to the display.

5. Report

A report was sent to the committee members ahead of the meeting. The following areas were discussed in more detail:

Technology – there have been various pieces of technology trialled to enable hybrid meeting, but this often involves individuals using their personal social media accounts. It was agreed that individuals should not be expected to do this and there should be a clear separation of personal social media and RTC/TOC.

Resolved: It was resolved that all social media applications used will not be personal accounts.

Volunteers – There are 11 active volunteers and it was agreed that more were needed to ensure the opening of TOC on a regular basis. Peter Daniels was thanked for writing a piece for Town & Around from a volunteer's point of view and he has kindly agreed to reissue this article. It was suggested to contact Ysgol Brynhyfryd to offer volunteering opportunities to Welsh Bacc students and to contact Ruthin Local History Society, U3A and Ruthin and District Civic Association to enquire if their members would like to support TOC.

It was suggested that some form of incentive could be offered. It was agreed that the manager will contact the suggested organisations and investigate incentives.

Resolved: Suggested organisations will be contacted by the manager and she will investigate incentives.

Internet – There is a fibre broadband supply to TOC which has not yet been accessed. Quotes have been sought from two local companies to install 3 - 4 wifi access points and the associated costs of a monthly broadband subscription. Members requested a quote from a third local company.

Resolved: The manager will request a quote from a third local company.

Business rates – Another appeal will need to be submitted to the Valuation Office to ensure the correct rateable value is applied to the building. The previous appeal was refused. Cllr Redfern Oakes has offered to support with this process.

Resolved: The manager will work with Cllr Redfern Oakes and submit a new appeal.

6. AOB

Stalls outside TOC – At the request of the Town Clerk, the TOC Committee was asked to consider the drawing up of a protocol establishing criteria and authorisation process for the use of RTC owned land surrounding TOC.

Resolved: The manager will draft a protocol establishing the criteria and authorisation process.
